If you would like to join us, you should contact the Parish Clerk at the above address (either by post or email) for an application form. Completed application forms must be received by the Parish Clerk no later than mid-day on

<u>Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2024.</u> All applications received will be considered, at our Parish Council meeting later the same day when a vote will be taken to co-opt the new Parish Councillor.

To qualify, a person must be a British subject, over 18 years old and an elector; must reside within Churchstanton Parish or within three miles of it or occupy as owner or tenant any land or premises therein or have their principal or only place of work there and must not be disqualified from holding office as a Councillor.
